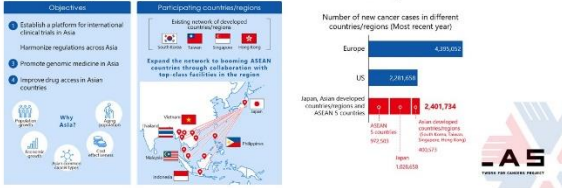

アジア全体における早期薬剤開発の推進と薬事承認を目指す国際共同試験の恒常的なプラットフォームの構築を目的としたATLAS projectは2020年9月に開始された。本プロジェクトは参加機関の臨床試験実施体制整備を行う拠点整備班、臨床試験に携わる人材の育成を担当する教育班、ATLASネットワーク内の医療機関との国際共同研究の計画・実施を担当する研究班で構成されており、各班の2021年における活動を報告する。また、ATLASプロジェクトを現地から支援するため2021年9月にタイのバンコクにアジア連携推進タイ事務所（APO）を開設した。ステークホルダーとの直接的なコミュニケーションによるネットワーク構築、ATLASネットワークを恒常的な臨床試験グループにまで発展させるためのガバナンス構築、ARO機能整備、シンポジウムやワークショップ等の企画・運営・参加を通じたATLASプロジェクト全体の広報活動を業務の柱としており、それぞれの内容について紹介していく。

ATLAS project was launched in September 2020 for early drug development and establishment of a permanent platform for international collaborative studies that aim at regulatory approval of a new cancer drug in Asian region. This project is composed of infrastructure and network team to reinforce the infrastructure for conducting clinical trials at collaborative sites, capacity building team which provides training program to those who are involved in clinical trials, and international clinical trials team that proposes new trials and manages execution of international collaborative researches within ATLAS network. Our activities of each team in 2021 will be reported. In September 2021, Asian Partnerships Office (APO) was established in Bangkok, Thailand, to support acceleration of ATLAS project. APO has four pillars: Networking, Governance, Clinical Trials Support, and Publicity. APO will engage in the establishment of robust networks with all stakeholders through direct communication, the establishment of governance to develop ATLAS network into a permanent clinical trial group, the development of ARO functions, and the publicity to make all activities of ATLAS project widespread in the world to through the organizing and participating in international events such as symposiums and workshops.

Asian Clinical Trials Network for Cancers (ATLAS) Project

In September 2020, the National Cancer Center Hospital launched the "Asian Clinical Trials Network for Cancers (ATLAS) Project". This project aims to establish a system for implementing cancer genomic medicine across Asia, and build the largest clinical research and trials network in the region.

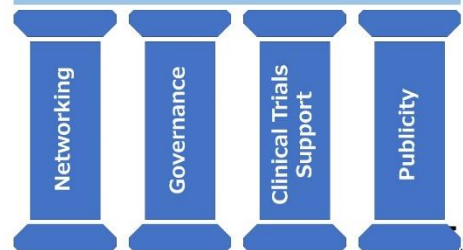

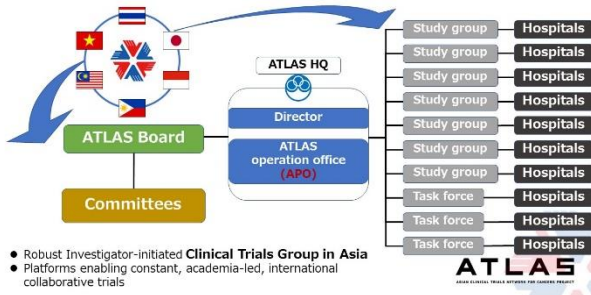
We plan to move to "a permanent office" until end of April 2022.
